State Parks teamed up at MacKerricher State Park on **Thursday, January 24**, to begin a project to propagate native plants to refurbish campsites. Mario Abreu, naturalist/mycologist and DKY education chair, facilitated this meeting and gave us an overview on seed collection, preparation and care. We also walked the area of a campsite to identify the shrubs/trees and get an idea of what the project will entail. State Parks set up the greenhouse at MacKerricher State Park and will maintain the seedlings. Our part will be to help gather cuttings or seeds to be propagated. *Thank you* Kay Rex for bringing this project to our attention and continuing to be our liaison with Calif. State Parks.

Fort Bragg Rotary Club and Mendocino Coast Sports Foundation, again this year, asked FBGC to donate a gift basket to raffle off at their Annual Crab Feed.
