1. Remove the aloe (divide it, pot it up and sell it at the yard sale)
2. Add coprosmas, phormium, and Actostaphylos "Emerald Carpet"
3. Rearrange the rocks that are there
4. Top-off with wood chips

So, on **TUES JULY 9 at 1:00** we'll bring pick-ups and shovels to remove a lot of the dirt/rocks that need to go before we add the new plants. Since the plot is not too large, we may not need many additional workers - but we'd love to have you join us as we can always use "sidewalk supervisors" (a term I learned from Ruth Sparks), camaraderie, and encouragement. The plants and chips will be added at a later date (day/time tbd).

 - Last year we had 9 tables. We have 4 here at our house and could use **5 more**. So...a **request for tables**, and wishes for many workers bees.
 - You can **bring goods any day starting Aug 1st**. Please call ahead. We will **set up** the day/evening before (**on Fri., Aug. 9**).
 - I will set up pot luck eats. Jary will have hot coffee and tea for us. I will have juices, fresh fruit and nuts, veggies and cheeses/meats for sandwiches - perhaps some members can bring chips and dips. If anyone else wishes to bring something wonderful to eat or drink, we will be using our kitchen and back porch. Bring whatever you wish.
- This year we'll have a "**nothing under \$1.00**" rule! If you want to sell something for less than a dollar - please put things together (in a group/bag/container) and price it at \$1.00 or more. LET'S BE KIND TO OUR CASHIERS.
- There will be a big "FREE" box outside the yard for all the little things that we might want to give away.
- If you wish to bring **clothes**, you **must** have some way to keep them neat and displayed. I do not have a standing rack. If you bring clothes **you** need to be at the table to manage your pile for the day and take them away when you leave.
